## What is the Delivering Better Value in SEND (DBV) programme?



The government has given North East Lincolnshire Local Authority and 54 other local authorities some grant funding. This is money from the government to help us improve outcomes for <u>all</u> children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.



The government have asked the local authority to be bold and think about new ways that money for SEND can be used. They have challenged us to spend money differently than we have in the past to try and get better outcomes. They have called this 'Delivering Better Value in SEND'.



The government have asked us to make sure we talk to children and young people with SEND and their families and make sure we really listen to their views. We also must have good conversations with education settings and people from health and care who give support to children and young people with SEND.

The government have said we must carefully look at data and information about:

- how many children and young people need support?
- how much support they need and from who?
- how much the support costs?

This information will then be used to explore new ideas about support for SEND.



NE Lincolnshire local authority have started taking to people and making plans together. We will be:

- 1. working with schools and SENCos to help them improve their SEND knowledge and skills.
- 2. working with health care proffesionals to improve their capacity so there is better timely support for families who need support for Social Emotional and Mental Health needs (SEMH) and / or Autism Spectrum Condition (ASC).
